What the program looks like

- Selected candidates will be hired in the Netherlands as Dutch employees and then assigned to our sites across Europe.

- Before the first assignment, new hires complete an induction/onboarding program in the Netherlands.
- A complete training program is in place to support career progression.
- Once the program is completed (maximum nine years), participants transfer to one of the European manufacturing sites to continue their careers.

Terms and Conditions of Employment


